What is The Student Voice?

Currently, most electronic safeguarding systems focus on listening to adults in the community. However, as Carlene Firmin (2017) suggests, students may not readily share such information with adults.

The Student Voice is an interactive and child-friendly reporting tool for young people that encompasses all aspects of their wellbeing, and all of the contexts they spend time in.

Complimenting adult reporting systems, schools and DSLs are able to provide immense wrap around safeguarding provision; supporting the individual, whilst using the contextual data to implement targeted interventions, and prevent future harm occurring in those spaces. It is helping DSLs tackle the full range of issues, from child-on-child abuse issues, to mental health, bullying and online safety.

Why do schools use The Student Voice?

- Engages young people with its child-friendly, visual and intuitive features.
- ✓ Covers all contexts young people spend time in (home, school & local community).
- Provides the context, not just the incident, so you can support the individual and prevent future harm from occurring in those spaces.
- ✓ Has engaged young people with issues that were previously reflected through their behaviour, which staff have been able to provide further support for.
- Covers the full range of issues from sexual harassment to mental health, bullying, home life, and online safety.
- ✓ **Bridges any** student-teacher **communication gaps** with a comfortable experience.


